

Curving and Bowing

Curving and bowing is very common in handmade carpets. It is the result of rolling the carpet. If the carpet is not rolled exactly straight it will demonstrate a slight bow when unrolled. The carpet is squared during all phases of production and will return to a straight / square piece after unrolling. The carpet should be squared on the floor using weights or tacking the corners and then allowed to acclimate for 24 – 48 hours. This will allow the carpet to return to its manufactured shape. This is not considered a manufacturing defect as carpet is a textile and some stretching or bowing can occur.
